#### **DEVELOPMENT OF CRUISE TERMINALS IN TAMIL NADU**

#### 3561. SHRI P. RAVINDHRANATH:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned projects for the development of Cruise Terminals and related infrastructure in Tamil Nadu under the scheme for Assistance for Tourism Infrastructure Development;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with financial sanctions made by the Government for the development of cruise terminals in Tamil Nadu and other States in the country;
- (c) whether the Government has also planned to set an agency/board for the development of tourism through cruises at national and international levels; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the follow-up actions taken by the Government in this regard?

#### ANSWER

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a): Yes, Sir. The Ministry sanctioned the project 'Cruise Passenger Facilities Centre in the Existing Passenger Terminal at Chennai Port' in 2012-13. The project has been completed in September 2017.

(b): Details of projects sanctioned for development of cruise terminals in various states is as Annexure.

(c) & (d): In order to harness the potential of Cruise Tourism in the country, a Task Force has been constituted with Secretary (Tourism) as the Chairman and Secretary (Shipping) as the Co-chairman. The Task Force consists of representatives from Ministries of Health, Home Affairs, External Affairs along with representatives of ports, Customs, CISF, Coastal States, etc. The 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Task Force on Cruise Tourism was held on 27.04.2022.

Further, the first Incredible India International Cruise Conference was held on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 in Mumbai in collaboration with the Ministry of Shipping to bring all stakeholders together.
