(a) to (b) To showcase and spread awareness amongst the masses about the culture and heritage of our country, the Government of India has set up seven Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) with headquarters at Patiala, Nagpur, Udaipur, Prayagraj, Kolkata, Dimapur and Thanjavur. The Ministry of Culture, Government of India has organized twelve (12) Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsavs (RSMs) up till now through seven Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs). These ZCCs also conduct outreach programmes in far flung areas in the country to make the masses aware about the various art forms of India including its vast ancient culture.
