PENDING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

QUESTION

36. SHRI KANUMURU RAGHU RAMA KRISHNA RAJU:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the pending infrastructure projects in the country including Andhra Pradesh which is a key concern;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the corrective steps being taken in this regard, State-wise; and
- (c) the number of projects identified till date and the progress made in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PANKAJ CHAUDHARY)

(a) to (c): To monitor the progress of infrastructure projects in the country, Union Government launched the National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP) with projected infrastructure investment of Rs. 111 lakh crore during the period 2020-2025. Under NIP, infrastructure projects of Central Ministries, State Governments and private projects, with total project cost greater than Rs. 100 crore are captured. At present, the pipeline consists of over 9,300 projects covering 35 sub-sectors. The stage-wise NIP project details including project completion status are in the public domain on NIP/IIG Portal at https://indiainvestmentgrid.gov.in/opportunities/nip-projects which is periodically updated by the concerned central ministries/departments/ State Governments etc.

In addition, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) monitors all Central Sector Infrastructure Projects above Rs.150 crores through Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS) for removal of bottlenecks and facilitating the speedy implementation of major projects.
