DEVELOPMENT OF HISTORICAL DISTRICTS OF UTTAR PRADESH

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plans to develop the historical districts of Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the plans being prepared by the Government for district Rampur, once the pride of Indian history;
- (c) whether the Government has any plans to develop the three temples of Lord Shiva of Pandavas time located in Rathauda village, Bhamraua village, and Punjab Nagar village including Raza Library, Mahatma Gandhi Samadhi Sthal Planetarium, Fort and lake construction works on Kosi river dam as tourist spots in Rampur district; and
- (d) if not, the time by which the Government proposes to develop the said places as tourist spots?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The Ministry of Tourism (MoT) under 'Swadesh Darshan' (SDS), 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation, Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies' schemes provides financial assistance to the States/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies for development infrastructure in the country including Uttar Pradesh. The projects under identified in consultation with the the scheme are Governments/Union Territory Administrations/central Agencies and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, receipt of suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier etc.

The details of the projects sanctioned under above mentioned schemes in Uttar Pradesh including the historical places is annexed.

MoT has now revamped its SDS as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible destinations following a tourist & destination centric approach. No proposal has been received from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh for development of Rampur under SD 2.0 and PRASHAD schemes in line with the guidelines. However, Ayodhya has been included under PRASHAD schemes as per the request received from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh.
