- (d) the details of the steps taken/being taken for the said restoration work along with the total expenditure involved therein?

- (a) Yes, Sir. Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) undertakes conservation works of to 743 monuments, including 144 temples, in Uttar Pradesh. Conservation of
- (c) monuments is a continuous process. Works are carried out by ASI as per site requirement and available resources. All monuments including temples are in a good state of preservation. List of ASI protected temples in Uttar Pradesh is placed at Annexure- I.
- (d) The amount spent on conservation, restoration and preservation of Centrally Protected monuments including temples located in Uttar Pradesh is given as under:
