Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government organizes Rozgar Mela throughout the country to provide suitable employment opportunities in Private sector to the unemployed youth to give impetus to the employment initiatives in the country;
- (b) whether any Rozgar mela has been organised by the Government in Darbhanga district of Bihar;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) if not, whether the Government proposes to organize any Employment Fair in Darbhanga district of Bihar in future; and
- (e) if so, the time by when and the details thereof?

(a) Under various Skill India initiatives, Rozgar Melas are being organized across the country to facilitate the placement opportunities for the certified candidates. It is an event where skill trained candidates and employers are brought to a common platform to ensure best recruitment/selection choices for an employer and appropriate job opportunities for a skill trained candidate. Rozgar Melas are organized by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKKs), Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) and Training Providers (TPs) under the aegis of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

In addition, Ministry has launched Aatmanirbhar Skilled Employees Employer Mapping (ASEEM) portal, which acts as a central directory of skilled workforce registered and certified under Skill India Portal (SIP), across all schemes at central and state level.

(b) to (e) The Government proposes to organize Pradhan Mantri National Apprenticeship Melas (PMNAM) across the country on a monthly basis. States / UTs have accordingly been advised to organize PMNAM every 2nd Monday in 1/3 of total number of districts with the flexibility for choosing the district / location and the day of Mela based on local conditions / festivals, etc. so that all districts are covered once in a quarter, and four times in a year. So far, two PMNAM have been conducted in month of June and July, 2022 covering 26 Districts of the state of Bihar.
