ESI HOSPITALS IN MAHARASHTRA

37. SHRI SHRINIWAS PATIL:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of ESI hospitals in the State of Maharashtra and their locations;**
- (b) whether it is a fact that there is shortage of doctors, technicians and paramedical staff in these hospitals; if so, the details thereof, hospital-wise and the reasons therefor;**
- (c) the steps proposed to be taken by Government to fill up vacant posts of doctors and other staff;**
- (d) whether the Government proposes to improve the facilities in ESI hospitals and enhance their standard and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) whether the Government has received any request or proposal for ESIC Hospital in Satara District of Maharashtra, if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Details of 15 Employees' State Insurance (ESI) hospitals functioning in the State of Maharashtra, position in respect of doctors and paramedical staff including technicians thereof are placed at Annexure.

(c): For Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) hospitals in Maharashtra, 39 vacancies of the Specialists have been advertised for recruitment. In addition, 1120 vacancies of Insured Medical Officers (IMO) for ESIC hospitals in the country including vacancies in the state of Maharashtra have been advertised.

The ESI Corporation (ESIC), in its meeting on 18-19 June 2022, has decided to hire full time Specialists/ Super Specialist for various State Government run ESI Scheme (ESIS) hospitals. Further, the State Governments have been asked to maintain level of manpower in accordance with sanctioned strength as per ESIC norms.

(d): For improving the facilities and enhance their standards, ESIC has taken a number of initiatives, some of which are as under: -

- i. Formation of State level ESI Societies so that States have financial freedom to take decision for improvement of medical services.**
- ii. Project Implementation Plan (PIP) for state ESI Scheme.**
- iii. Enhancement of 50% of bed strength, if bed occupancy is more than 70% in ESIC/ESIS hospitals for last consecutive three years.**

Also, ESIC provides Rs. 200/- per Insured Person (IP) annum over and above ceiling to the State Government, where the bed occupancy in all the State ESIS hospitals is more than 70% during the concluded financial year.

(e): ESI Corporation during its 188th meeting held on 18-19 June 2022 has given in-principle approval for setting up of a 100 bedded hospital in Satara district of Maharashtra.
