(a) and (b) Ministry of Textiles has implemented Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) till 2017-18. Under which, a National workshop was held on 27.08.2015 with a view to showcase the milestones achieved and to gain feedback from various stakeholders with active collaboration of industry partners and other institutions implementing the scheme. A list of invitees of the National Workshop on Integrated Skill Development Scheme, comprising textile industries and institutions, held on 27.08.2015 is at *Annexure*.

(c) and (d) Ministry of Textiles is presently implementing Samarth- Scheme for Capacity Building in Textiles Sector for addressing the skilled manpower needs across textiles sector.
