- (a) whether it is true that nearly 40 per cent of Gramin Dak Sevak posts are lying vacant in Telangana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, district-wise; and
- (c) the time since when these are lying vacant and the steps taken by the Government to fill these vacancies?

- (a) No Sir. 23.70 % posts of Gramin Dak Sewaks are lying vacant.
- (b) & (c) The details are furnished in the **Annexure**. The vacant posts are filled through engagement process, transfer, compassionate engagement etc. Engagement of GDS is a continuous process. In respect of 1799 posts, engagement exercise is underway.
