RURAL HOUSEHOLDS COVERED UNDER THE PMGDSA

614. SHRI RAMDAS C. TADAS:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the district-wise details of the total number of rural households covered under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDSA) in the State of Maharashtra;
- (b) the district-wise details of the number of rural families of backward/most backward classes covered under the PMGDSA in the State of Maharashtra; and
- (c) whether any plan has been formulated to take this campaign to every nook and corner of the State of Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

- (a): Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA) was approved in February 2017 to usher in digital literacy with a target to cover 6 crore rural households (1 person per household) across the country including the state of Maharashtra. District-wise details of candidates registered, trained and certified under the PMGDISHA scheme in the state of Maharashtra is given at Annexure- I.
- (b): Under the PMGDISHA scheme, at the time of candidate registration, the community of candidates is captured in one of the categories namely General, Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward Classes. The details regarding Backward/ Most backward classes is not separately captured. The district-wise details of Other Backward Class candidates covered under PMGDISHA in the rural areas of Maharashtarais given at Annexure- II.
- (c): The coverage of the Scheme in the state of Maharashtra is fairly well spread as can be seen from the fact that as against the indicative target of 44.33 lakhcandidates, so far, a total of 46.63 lakh candidates have been enrolled and 38.75 lakh candidates have been trained, out of which 27.81 lakh candidates have been duly certified. Further, in the state of Maharashtra, there are 28,156 Gram Panchayats and all of them are covered under the PMGDISHA scheme.
