HAR GHAR JAL YOJANA IN RAJASTHAN

†779. SHRIMATI JASKAUR MEENA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of Har Ghar Jal Yojana;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilised under this scheme in Rajasthan in the country during the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the number of families covered under this scheme in Rajasthan so far;
- (d) whether the Government has any data of families who remained uncovered in Rajasthan particularly those living in rural areas; and
- (e) if so, the time by which such families are likely to be covered under the scheme?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) Since August 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including those in the State of Rajasthan, by 2024. The key features of the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) are to make provision of potable water to every rural household through tap water connection at a service level of 55 litre per capita per day (lpcd), of prescribed quality (BIS:10500), on regular and long-term basis.

As reported by State Government, out of total 105.69 lakh rural households in Rajasthan, 27.30 lakh (25.83%) households have been provided with tap water connections as on 18th July 2022. The details of households provided with tap water connection and households that are remaining are updated daily on 'JJM-Dashboard' which is public domain and can be accessed using weblink: <https://ejalshakti.gov.in/jjmreport/JJMIndia.aspx>.
