STATUS OF JAL JEEVAN MISSION

802. SHRIMATI KIRRON KHER:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of Jal Jeevan Mission and the roadmap for the same;
- (b) the steps taken for Chandigarh under Jal Jivan Mission (JJM); and
- (c) the details of gram panchayats yet to be connected under Jal Jeevan Mission?

ANSWER

(a) Since, August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household by 2024. At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, 3.24 Crore (17%) household were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, tap water connections have been provided to additional 6.57 Crore (34%) rural households. Thus, as of 18.07.2022, out of 19.15 Crore rural households in the country, provision of tap water supply has been made to 9.81 Crore (51%) households. Tap water connection to 9.34 crore remaining households (49%) are planned to be provided by 2024. The detailed information related to status as well as progress in making the provision of tap water supply to rural households in the country is in public domain on JJM–dashboard and available at:

(b) Chandigarh UT has not reported rural households. Hence, JJM is not implemented in Chandigarh.

(c) As reported by States/ UTs on JJM-IMIS, out of 2.66 lakh Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country, tap water connections have been provided to all rural households in 73,636 GPs (28%). Tap water connection is yet be provided in 9.34 crore households in 1.92 lakh GPs. Details are available at :
