### LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 809 TO BE ANSWERED ON 21.07.2022

#### **OPERATIONAL/CLOSED MSMEs IN ODISHA**

809. SHRI MAHESH SAHOO:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) currently in operation in Odisha, district-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has the data of MSMEs that were shut down during the last three years in Odisha, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has made any assessment of the reason for closing down of the MSMEs causing unemployment to a large number of people and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of people who lost their job in the State of Odisha during the said period, district-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

- (a): The details of the number of MSMEs currently in operation in Odisha, district-wise are at Annexure-I.
- (b) & (d): The district-wise data of MSMEs that were shut down and employment lost in last three years in Odisha, as per the erstwhile Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum and Udyam Registration data, is at Annexure-II.
- (c): National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) under Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) had conducted a study during August, 2020 with a sample size of 5,774 MSMEs, across 32 States/UTs. It was found that 91% of MSMEs were functional and Five most critical problems faced by MSMEs were identified as Liquidity (55% units), Fresh Orders (17% units), Labour (9% units), Logistics (12% units) and availability of Raw Material (8% units).
