**PIPED DRINKING WATER SUPPLY**

830. DR. NISHIKANT DUBEY:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of households having piped drinking water supply, State/ UT-wise including Jharkhand, especially Santhal Pargana; and
- (b) the percentage of households using hand pump water for drinking purpose, State/ UT-wise?

(a) & (b) As on date, out of 19.15 Crore rural households in the country, around 9.81 Crore (51.22%) households are reported to have tap water supply. As reported by States/ UTs including Jharkhand, number of households with functional tap water connection, is at **Annex-I**. These details are in public domain and available on the JJM dashboard at

<https://ejalshakti.gov.in/jjmreport/JJMIndia.aspx>.

Further, State of Jharkhand has informed that out of 15.36 lakh rural households in Santhal Pargana area spreading over 6 districts, so far 2.39 lakh rural households are getting potable water through tap connection.

This Department does not maintain data related to percentage of households using hand pump for drinking purpose.
