TARGETS FIXED UNDER JAL JEEVAN MISSION

896. SHRI BHOLANATH (B.P. SAROJ):

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to achieve the targets fixed under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in rural areas of Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the details of tap water connections given under JJM in Uttar Pradesh, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Union Government has sanctioned sufficient funds to Uttar Pradesh to provide tap water connections in rural areas; and
- (d) if so, the details of funds allocated to Uttar Pradesh during the last three years and the current year, year-wise?

ANSWER

(a) &(b) Since August 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including those in the State of Uttar Pradesh, by 2024.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, 5.16 lakh households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, 34.07 lakh rural households have been provided with tap water connections in last 35 months. Thus, as of date, out of 264.28 lakh rural households in the State, 39.23 lakh households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes. The State/ UT, district & village-wise status of tap water connection in rural households, schools and anganwadi centres etc. as reported by States/ UTs is in public domain and available on JJM dashboard at:

Number of steps have been taken to plan and implement JJM in the whole country, including Uttar Pradesh, with speed, *inter alia*, which includes joint discussion and finalization of annual action plan (AAP) of States/ UTs, regular review of implementation, workshops/ conferences/ webinars for capacity building and knowledge sharing, field visits by multi-disciplinary team to provide technical support, etc. A detailed Operational Guideline for the implementation of JJM; Margdarshika for Gram Panchayats & VWSCs to provide safe drinking water in rural households and Guidelines on a special campaign to provide piped water supply in anganwadi centres, ashramshalas and schools have been shared with States/ UTs, including Uttar Pradesh, to

facilitate planning and implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission. For online monitoring, JJM–Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) and JJM–Dashboard has been put in place. Provision has also been made for transparent online financial management through Public Financial Management System (PFMS).

(c) & (d) Under JJM, funds are allocated to States/ UTs, including the State of Uttar Pradesh, as per approved criteria for fund allocation. Based on the reported expenditure and proposals received from the States/ UTs, requisite funds are made available to them.

Central fund allocated, fund drawn and fund utilization reported by the State of Uttar Pradesh under Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 (as on 18.07.2022) is as under:

In addition, JJM being time-bound country-wide programme, additional fund is also made available to better performing States/ UTs, at the fag end of financial year, to incentivize their good performance out of the fund unclaimed by other States/ UTs.
