- (a) whether the Government has any plan to construct new roads in metropolitan areas in Kerala to improve traffic safety and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has any plan to construct a bypass between National Highway-66 (Cherthala) and MC Road (Kottayam) and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to upgrade NH-66 to a fourlane road throughout its length in the State; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

## THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) DPR for Construction of Outer Ring Road (ORR) to Thiruvananthapuram city in the State of Kerala is in progress.

- (b) At present no such plan is under consideration in the Ministry.
- (c)&(d) Yes, the entire length of NH 66 in Kerala is being up-graded to 4/6 lane configuration. Up-gradation of 42 km length has already been completed. Up-gradation of 590 km length is under progress & project covering 13 km is under bidding stage.
