- (a) whether the process of land acquisition has been completed and construction work on the Delhi-Amritsar- Katra Expressway under the Bharatmala Pariyojana has commenced and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of funds allocated, released and utilised for the construction of the said expressway;
- (c) the name of towns/cities in Haryana through which the said expressway will pass; and
- (d) the present staus of the project in Haryana and time frame set for completion of this project?

(a) & (b) Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway comprising length of 668 Km with total Capital Cost of Rs. 37,525 crore is passing through the State of Haryana, Punjab and UT Jammu & Kashmir. Works in a length of 597 km have been awarded, after acquisition of land as per the provisions contained in the Contract/Concession Agreements. The State-wise details are as under:

(c) & (d) The work in entire stretch falling in the State of Haryana for a length of 158 Km has already been started. The project Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway in the State of Haryana starts at interchange with Kundali-Manesar-Palwal (KMP) Expressway in Jhajhar District and passes through the districts of Jhajhar, Rohtak, Sonepat, Jind, Karnal and Kaithal. The stretch passing through State of Haryana has been scheduled for completion by March, 2024.
