DRINKING WATER UNDER HAR GHAR JAL SCHEME

†919. SHRIMATI GEETA KORA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of villages of Jharkhand being provided drinking water under Har Ghar Jal Scheme; and
- (b) the reasons for not providing drinking water after construction of water tanks in the villages along with number of such villages?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) Since August 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including in all 29,604 villages of Jharkhand, by 2024.
- (b) Drinking Water being a State subject, it is States, who plan, design, approve and implement drinking water supply schemes. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical and financial assistance. As such details of individual projects/ schemes for rural water supply projects are not maintained at the Government of India level. However, as informed by the Govt. of Jharkhand, the construction of water tanks with necessary pipelines and allied structures for water supply schemes are underway.
