STATUS OF SAGARMALA PROGRAMME IN ANDHRA PRADESH

973. SHRI RAM MOHAN NAIDU KINJARAPU:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of projects under Sagarmala Programme in Andhra Pradesh along with the details of projects sanctioned and completed, cost of the projects, date of completion and State's contribution thereof;
- (b) the present status and complete details of tourism passenger jetty project at Baruva and Kalingapatnam port along with fishing harbor project at Bandaruvani Peta;
- (c) the details of funds allocated/utilised, year-wise including current status of these projects along with the details of projects sanctioned but works not yet started; and
- (d) the details of works completed in Srikakulam in Andhra Pradesh under Sagarmala Project along with the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) About 119 Projects worth more than Rs 1 Lac Cr. have been identified under Sagarmala Programme in the State of Andhra Pradesh for enhancing the infrastructure related to Port led Industrialization, Port Modernization, Port Connectivity enhancement, Coastal Community Development & Coastal Shipping and Inland Waterways. These projects are implemented by Central Ministries, IWAI, Indian Railways, NHAI, State Government and Major Ports etc. Additionally, in the state of Andhra Pradesh, a total of 52 projects with an estimated cost of Rs. 1,930 Cr have been identified for implementation under Holistic Development of Coastal Districts.

There are 13 projects worth Rs. 1533 Cr partially funded through Sagarmala Programme in Andhra Pradesh. Out of these 13 Projects, 5 projects worth Rs 754 Cr have been completed, 3 projects worth Rs. 316 Cr. are under implementation and 5

projects worth Rs. 463 Cr. are under development. The list of Project funded by the Ministry under Sagarmala is annexed.

(b) & (c) The details of projects 'Passenger jetty at Kalingapatnam', 'Tourism Passenger Jetty Project in Baruva' and 'Fishing Harbour in Bandaruvani Peta' along with funds allocated and current status is as under:

3.	Fishing Harbour in Bandaruvani Peta	-	-	Govt of AP has informed that no fishing harbour is being developed in Bandaruvani Peta, Srikakulam district. A fishing harbour is being developed at Budagatlapalem in Srikakulam district by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The fishing harbour will be developed as part of the 9 fishing harbours being developed in the state. Budagatlapalem will be developed as part of Phase II of the initiative.

(d) The Government of Andhra Pradesh is developing a greenfield port in Bhavanapadu, Srikakulam district. The said project is being developed and funded entirely by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
