### \*174 SHRI SELVAM G:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram in the country including Tamil Nadu, if so, the details thereof and achievements made since its inception, year-wise/State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has made any assessment of the said scheme through social audit, if so, the findings thereof, year-wise;
- (c) the details of the number of children covered under the said scheme in the State of Tamil Nadu along with the amount of funds allocated/utilized during the last three years, year-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government has taken any steps for children with any health condition to be referred to an appropriate health facility for further management, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

### STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 174 FOR 2<sup>ND</sup> AUGUST, 2024

(a) to (d) Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) implements Rashtriya Bal Swasthaya Karyakram (RBSK) in all States/UTs, including Tamil Nadu, under National Health Mission (NHM) for children in the age group 0-18 years in Anganwadi centres, Government and Government aided schools with the objective of early identification and management for 32 selected health conditions - 4 D's i.e. Defects at Birth, Developmental delays, Diseases and Deficiencies.

As reported by States/UTs, 160.84 crore children have been screened through Mobile Health Teams (MHTs), 11.90 crore children have been identified with selected health conditions and 5.64 crore children have been provided secondary/tertiary care from FY 2014-15 till FY 2023-24 under RBSK. State/UT wise details are placed at **Annexure-1**.

The RBSK Program is evaluated under NHM through review of quarterly reports, field visits and periodic meetings with State Nodal Officers, reviews done during the process of Annual Programme Implementation Plans (APIP) and Common Review Missions (CRM).

The financial support is provided to the States/UTs under the NHM for RBSK based on the Annual Program Implementation Plan (APIP) submitted by States/ UTs. The support is given for infrastructure, essential equipment, human resources including capacity building for comprehensive management. The State/UT-wise details of the budget allocation and utilization for RBSK is placed at **Annexure-2.** 

The establishment of District Early Intervention Centre (DEIC) is an important component of the RBSK for management of children. They provide linkages with health facilities for free secondary and tertiary care including surgical management of selected health conditions at Medical colleges and empanelled private health facilities. As per the reports submitted by States/UTs, 430 DEICs are operational throughout the country. The Cumulative details of Children covered under RBSK State/UT wise are given at **Annexure-3**.
