ASPIRE SCHEME IN ANDHRA PRADESH

*241. SHRI PUTTA MAHESH KUMAR:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the total number of beneficiaries and youth (both men and women) under A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industries and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE) scheme during the last five years, State-wise, and district-wise for Andhra Pradesh including Eluru district;

(b) the details of the total number of Technology Business Incubators and Livelihood Business Incubators set up under the said scheme in Andhra Pradesh during the last five years;

(c) the amount of funds allocated and utilised under the said scheme in Andhra Pradesh during the said period, year-wise; and

(d) whether the Government has conducted any promotional campaign to increase awareness regarding the said scheme, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): A Statement laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO THE PARTS OF (a) to (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *241 FOR ANSWER ON 08.08.2024.

(a): As per the available records, a total number of 57,331 persons were benefitted under "A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship" (ASPIRE) during the last four years. In Andhra Pradesh, during the said period, 1,671 persons were benefitted. No proposal for setting up of Livelihood Business Incubator (LBI) has been received from Eluru district of Andhra Pradesh. The State wise details of beneficiaries including Andhra Pradesh, are provided in **Annexure-I**. The district wise details for Andhra Pradesh are provided in **Annexure-II**.

(b): During last five years, 2 Technology Business Incubators (TBIs) and 4 Livelihood Business Incubators (LBIs) have been set up in Andhra Pradesh under ASPIRE. The details of the TBIs and LBIs are provided at **Annexure-III**.

(c): The year wise details regarding the total funds sanctioned and utilized under the ASPIRE Scheme in Andhra Pradesh during the last five years is provided at **Annexure-IV**. During the last five years, a total of Rs. 399.17 Lakhs was sanctioned for setting up of 4 LBIs and 2 TBIs in Andhra Pradesh out of which Rs. 299.68 lakh has been utilized as per demand received.

(d): To promote the ASPIRE Scheme, 02 Mentor Institutes namely, Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship (IIE), Guwahati and Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), Ahmedabad, have been on-boarded for mentoring and submitting quality proposals in addition to handholding the LBIs in implementation and day to day operations. 12 targeted workshops have been organized to equip potential applicants with the necessary skills and knowledge for benefitting under ASPIRE. The details of workshops are provided at **Annexure V.** In addition, Government regularly conducts number of awareness programs in order to create awareness about all MSME Schemes including ASPIRE in the country. In the last 5 years, a total of 19,751 programmes were conducted for 8,98,528 beneficiaries.
