CONSTRUCTION OF RING ROAD IN ANANTAPUR

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned construction of a ring road around Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof including the length, estimated cost and the timeline set for completion of the project;**
- (b) whether any feasibility studies and environmental impact assessment have been conducted for the said project and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the details of the funds allocated and released for the said project so far; and**
- (d) whether there are any challenges or delays in the implementation of the project and if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?**

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 244 TO BE ANSWERED ON 8TH AUGUST, 2024 ASKED BY SHRI G LAKSHMINARAYANA REGARDING 'CONSTRUCTION OF RING ROAD IN ANANTAPUR'.

(a) to (d) No sir. No such proposal is under consideration by the Ministry. However, 4-laning of Anantapur-Muchukota section of NH-544D with a total project cost of Rs 907.76 crore has been sanctioned by the Ministry which inter-alia includes construction of a bypass for Anantapur city having 8.1 km length. The scheduled completion date for the project is 21.07.2025.
