OPERATION GREENS SCHEME UNDER PMKSY

***248. DR. SHRIKANT EKNATH SHINDE:**
SHRI RAJESH VERMA:

Will the **MINISTER OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the impact of the Operation Greens scheme introduced under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY), State-wise, focusing on the products included and financial assistance extended;
- (b) whether there is any proposal to extend the said scheme to include additional food products and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of disbursement and utilization of incentive amounts along with the details of the claims processed and various food product segments to which these incentives are being granted under the Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry (PLISFPI) since its implementation in 2023-24;
- (d) whether the Government has collaborated with industry experts, research institutions or international partners to ensure the alignment of PLISFPI with global best practices and market demands and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the total number of farmers benefitted from PMKSY in the country along with the allocated budget outlay for the scheme during the 14th Finance Commission Cycle and its continuation into the 15th Finance Commission Cycle; and
- (f) the details of specifics regarding newly introduced schemes and the restructuring of existing schemes under PMKSY?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (f) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *248 ANSWERED ON 08.08.2024 REGARDING ‘OPERATION GREENS SCHEME UNDER PMKSY’

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has been implementing a Central Sector Scheme- “Operation Greens” (OG) under Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana since 2018-19, with the objective of enhancing the value realisation for farmers and minimizing post-harvest losses. The scope of OG Scheme has been expanded from three crops namely Tomato, Onion and Potato (TOP) to 22 perishable crops namely Mango, Banana, Apple, Pineapple, Orange, Grapes, Aonla/Amla, Pomegranate, Guava, Litchi, Tomato, Onion, Potato, Green Peas, Carrot, Cauliflower, Beans, Gourd Family {Bottle Gourd (Loki), Bitter Gourd (Karela), Ridge/Sponge Gourd (Torai) Pointed Gourd (Parval) and Ash Gourd (Petha)}, Okra, Garlic, Ginger and Shrimp, during the 15th Financial Commission Cycle (2021-26).

Under the scheme, 52 projects have been approved across the country for eligible crops in identified production clusters with grants in aid of ₹621.94 crores for total project cost of ₹2417.07 crores. The details of the projects approved under the scheme are in **Annexure**.

(c) & (d) The Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry was the part of approval of NITI Aayog’s proposal on “Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan for Enhancing India’s Manufacturing Capabilities and Enhancing Export” approved on 11.11.2020 for introduction of PLI scheme for 10 sector specific product lines including food processing sector. To formulate the PLI scheme for food processing sector, proactive steps were taken to align it with global best practices and market demands. An extensive stakeholder consultative approach was adopted to gather inputs from line Ministries and organizations i.e. Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEPA) and Agricultural & Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) etc.

Since its implementation, a total incentive of ₹1083.991 Crore has been disbursed in 84 eligible claims under different segments of PLI Scheme for FPI. Details of eligible claims and incentive disbursed so far is given below:

(e) &(f) A total no of 33,53,903 farmers have benefitted from 1022 projects completed under PMKSY in the country. The financial outlay for PM Kisan Sampada Yojana for 14th Finance Commission was ₹6,000 crores and for 15th Finance commission it was ₹5,520 crores. The specifics of the sub-component schemes under PMKSY are as follows:

- i. Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure
- ii. Scheme for creation of Infrastructure for Agro Processing Clusters
- iii. Scheme for Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities
- iv. Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure.
- v. Operation Greens
- vi. Human Resource and Institutions -Research & Development
