STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 24 BY SHRI GYANESHWAR PATIL TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 24.07.2024 REGARDING RESUMPTION OF DISCONTINUED TRAINS

(a) to (c) Indian Railways, with a view to provide better passenger safety by creating maintenance corridor blocks, minimizing conflicts in existing Time Table etc., have undertaken rationalization of time-table, in a scientific manner with the assistance of IIT-Bombay. As a part of rationalization of Time Table, the services of 22111/22112 Bhusaval-Nagpur Express via Itarsi has been discontinued. However, the Bhusaval-Nagpur sector is presently being served by 43 pairs of trains. Besides, introduction of new train services is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, availability of resources etc.
