PROGRESS OF THE E-SHRAM PORTAL FOR ASSAM

1013. SHRI GAURAV GOGOI:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)the current status of the e-Shram portal rollout for the State of Assam, district-wise;
- (b) the details of the number of registrations completed on the e-Shram portal by informal workers in the State of Assam as of June 2024, district-wise;
- (c)the details of the number of beneficiaries of the social security as guaranteed by the scheme as of June 2024, district-wise;
- (d)whether the Government has taken any steps to promote awareness and facilitate registration for informal workers in the said State on the e-Shram portal; and
- (e)if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (e): Ministry of Labour & Employment launched eShram portal (eshram.gov.in) on 26th August 2021 for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganised Workers verified and seeded with Aadhaar. eShram portal is meant to register and support the unorganised workers by providing them a Universal Account Number (UAN). As on 22nd July, 2024, over 29.82 crore unorganised workers have registered on eShram portal.

The district-wise details of unorganized workers registered in Assam who have received eShram cards are annexed.

Ministry has taken several steps to raise awareness and to expedite the registration of unorganised workers on eShram portal. Many registration camps and drives are being organised by Ministry from time to time in coordination with Common Service Centre (CSC). Social media platforms are also being used to spread awareness among workers to register on e-shram. State Seva Kendras (SSKs) and services of Common Service Centres were on boarded to facilitate assisted mode registrations of unorganised workers. eShram is also on boarded on Unified Mobile Application for New-age Governance (UMANG app), to increase reach among the workers and provide registration/ update facility at the convenience of their mobile.
