# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1180 ANSWERED ON 30/07/2024

#### **CRITERIA FOR MINIMUM WAGES**

### 1180 SHRI CHARANJIT SINGH CHANNI: SHRI RAMASHANKAR RAJBHAR: SHRI GURMEET SINGH MEET HAYER:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENTbe pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme(MGNREGS);
- (b) the details of the current daily wages provided by the Union Government underMGNREGS in the country, particularly in the States of Punjab and Haryana;
- (c) the criteria for determining minimum wages and working hours under the MGNREGS;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the minimum wages and working hours, ifso, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of man days being provided to the said workers in a month by the Government?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand-driven wage employment Scheme which provides for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. The objectives of the Mahatma Gandhi NREGS are as below:

- (i) Providing at least one hundred days of unskilled manual work in a financial year to every household in rural areas as per demand resulting in creation of productive assets of prescribed quality and durability;
- (ii) Strengthening the livelihood resource base of the poor;
- (iii) Proactively ensuring social inclusion and
- (iv) StrengtheningPanchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs)
- (b): State/UT-wise wage rates for unskilled workers under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS for the current financial year 2024-25, including Punjab and Haryana, are at Annexure-I.
- (c)&(d): As per Section 6 (1) of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), 2005, the Central Government may, by notification, specify the wage rate for its beneficiaries. The Government of India has been determining the wage rates using the Consumer Price Index for Agricultural Labour (CPI-AL) from the year 2011-12.

The Ministry of Rural Development revises the wage rate every financial year based on change in Consumer Price Index for Agricultural Labour (CPI-AL). The index is different for different States/UTs as notified by Labour Bureau Shimla. If the calculated wage rate of any State/UT as per the index for the current year results in lower wage rate than the wage rate of previous year, it is being protected by maintaining the previous year's wage rate. The revised wage rate is made applicable from 1st April of each financial year. However, each State/UT can provide wages over and above the wage rate notified by the Central Government.

As per para 19(a) &(b) of Schedule I of the Mahatma Gandhi NREGA, "the schedule of rates of wages for various unskilled labourers shall be fixed up so that an adult person worked for eight hours which include an hour of rest will earn a wage which is equal to the stipulated wage rate and the working hours of an adult worker shall be flexible but shall not spread over more than twelve hours on any day".

With regard to the change in the working hours of workers of Mahatma Gandhi NREGS, at present there is no plan to change the

working hours of workers of Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in this Ministry.

(e): Month-wise details of employment provided (in person-days generated) under the Mahatma Gandhi NREGS during the current Financial Year 2024-25 (as on 24.07.2024) are given in Annexure-II.
