SURVEY UNDER PMAY-G IN KARNATAKA

1238 Shri GovindMakthappaKarjol:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENTbe pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any survey under Pradhan MantriAwaasYojana -Gramin (PMAY-G) to find out the demand for housing in the State of Karnataka particularly inChitradurga and Tumkur District;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (c) the details of houses sanctioned, pending and completed under PMAY-G in Chitradurga,Tumkuru district, year-wise;
- (d) the details of allocation funds and utilization in Karnataka under the yojana during each of the last five years and current year, district-wise; and
- (e) the other steps taken by the Government to implement said yojana in Karnataka?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (DR. CHANDRA SEKHAR PEMMASANI)

(a) to (b): The identification of beneficiaries under PMAY-G is based on the housing deprivation parameters and exclusion criteria prescribed under Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC)-2011 and due verification by the respective Gram Sabhas and completion of an Appellate Process. These parameters/criteria was applied on SECC 2011 database to identify eligibility of beneficiary under PMAY-G. Further, the Government conducted Awaas+ survey through states/UTs during January 2018 to March 2019 to identify those beneficiaries which claimed to have been left out under the SECC 2011 survey and thus prepared an additional list of potentially eligible beneficiaries. During Awaas+ survey, a total of 3.90 crore potentially eligible households were registered by the States/UTs and after remanding/verification by Gram Sabhas, a total of 2.79 crore were found potentially eligible by the States/UTs. Of the overall mandate of 2.95 crore households, 2.04 crore beneficiary households have been identified from SECC 2011 survey database and to fill the gap of 91 lakh households (2.95-2.04), Awaas+ survey database was utilized after following due verification process by Gram Sabhas and Appellate Process thereafter.

Under PMAY-G, the overall mandated target of 2.95 crore houses has already been allocated to States/UTs, against which more than 2.946 crore houses have already been sanctioned to the beneficiaries and over 2.64 crore houses have already been completed as on 25.07.2024.

The details of the district-wise number of eligible households in the SECC 2011 based Permanent Wait List (PWL) and finalisedAwaas+2018 survey lists in the State of Karnataka particularly in Chitradurga and Tumkur District is given in Annexure-I.

(c): The Ministry allocates targets to the State and further allocation of targets to the Districts/ Blocks/ Gram Panchayats is done by the State Government. The details of the houses sanctioned, completed and pending against targets allocated under the PMAY-G in Chitradurga and Tumkuru district of Karnataka, year-wise for target years 2016-17 to 2023-24 is given in Annexure-II.

(d): Under Pradhan MantriAwaasYojana- Gramin (PMAY-G), the Ministry releases Central Share of funds directly to State/UT considering them as a single unit. Further disbursal of funds as installments of assistance to the beneficiaries is done by the State. The district-wise details of funds utilized (including state share) under during each of the last five years (from financial year 2019-20 to 2023-24) and current FY 2024-25 (as on 25.07.2024) is given in Annexure-III.

(e): The Ministry has taken the following initiatives to ensure timely completion of the houses under the PMAY-G:

- **1. Regular review of progress at the level of Ministry.**
- 2. Launch of PMAY-G analytic Dashboard for monitoring and supervision of the scheme.
- 3. Timely allocation of targets to the States/UTs and release of adequate funds.
- 4. Regular follow ups with the State to ensure release of central and state share of funds and provision of land to landless beneficiaries in rural areas.
- 5. Awards to the best performing States/UTs, Districts based on performance index dashboard, thereby creating healthy competition and motivation among the States/UTs for achieving the set targets.
