- (a) the details of the total number of Atal Tinkering Labs established in schools across the country during the last four years, State-wise especially in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the details of the total number of students participating in Atal Tinkering Labs across the country during the last four years, State-wise, especially in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the details of the total number of competitions, exhibitions, workshops and lecture series conducted under the Atal Tinkering Labs initiative during the last four years, State-wise especially in Andhra Pradesh;
- (d) the details of the total amount of funds allocated and utilised for setting up and functioning of Atal Tinkering Labs in various schools across the country, State-wise especially schools in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (e) whether the Government has considered to increase the total number of schools having Atal Tinkering Labs and if so, the details thereof?

(a) Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog has established a total of 10,000 Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs) across the country, out of which 713 ATLs have been established in Andhra Pradesh, from 2016-17 till date. Of these, a total of 5,022 ATLs have been established in the last four years, viz. 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 across the country, with 354 ATLs established in the state of Andhra Pradesh. The details of the total number of Atal Tinkering

Labs established in schools across the country during the last four years, State-wise including Andhra Pradesh is presented in the table below:

(c) AIM, NITI Aayog organizes national level competitions each year to provide a platform to the school students to showcase their innovative talent. One such flagship competition is ATL Marathon, which enables students to build prototypes of projects, using design thinking & research to solve community problems. Another competition is ATL Tinkerpreneur, which enable students to build their own digital products, while skilling themselves with modern tools & technologies. Some other competitions/challenges include ATL Space Challenge, ATL Tinkering Day, competitions organized in collaboration with industry partners etc. Further, the state-wise details of the total number of workshops, seminars and trainings conducted in Atal Tinkering Labs across the country in last four years, including Andhra Pradesh is presented in the table below:

(d) Each school has been sanctioned a total amount of Rs. 20 lakhs for establishment and operations of ATLs, over the period of five years. Out of this sanctioned amount, Rs. 10 lakhs have been sanctioned as establishment cost in first year and Rs. 10 lakhs have been sanctioned as operational cost, in five tranches of Rs. 2 lakhs each year.

Till date, all 10,000 established ATLs have been granted an amount of Rs. 12 lakhs as first tranche (Rs. 10 lakhs for establishment and Rs. 2 lakhs for operations & maintenance), resulting in a total disbursement amount of Rs. 1200 crores. Additionally, a total of Rs. 180.28 crores have been disbursed as subsequent tranches, for operations & maintenance.
