NON AVAILABILITY OF SUPERFAST TRAINS AT THAWE JUNCTION

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is fact that there is no superfast trains operational from Thawe junction to various metropolitan cities of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and measures taken to provide superfast train services at Thawe junction;
- (c) whether it is fact that lakhs of passengers deprived of train facilities under the area of Thawe junction is causing loss of revenue to Railways; and
- (d) whether it is fact that due to non-availability of trains, lakhs of passengers shifted to private bus services for metropolitan cities causing loss of revenue to Government and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) Thawe station is presently being served by 03 pairs of Mail/Express and 11 pairs of passenger train services. Further, trains to major cities can also be availed from nearby Siwan station. Besides, introduction of new trains is an on-going process on Indian Railways subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, resource availability, competing demands etc.
