Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the district-wise number of functional warehouses for food storage in Haryana and Bihar at present along with the number of farmers benefitted from these warehouses particularly in the Sonipat Parliamentary Constituency;
- (b) the total capacity of these warehouses and whether the capacity of these warehouses is sufficient for the storage of foodgrains received from the farmers of Haryana and Bihar;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set-up more warehouses in Haryana and Bihar; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Details of district-wise number of functional warehouses in Haryana and Bihar for storing foodgrains with Food Corporation of India (FCI) and the number of farmers getting benefits from procurement during Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2024-25 in the said districts are Annexed. Further, a total 66,411 farmers were benefitted in Sonipat Parliamentary Constituency under central pool procurement during RMS 2024-25.

As on 01.07.2024, Covered Storage capacity available with FCI (owned and hired) for storage of foodgrain stock is 56.55 Lakh MT (Haryana) and 10.68 Lakh MT (Bihar). Additionally, Covered Storage Capacity available with State agencies in Haryana and Bihar for storage of Central Pool foodgrain stock is 51.36 Lakh MT and 18.20 Lakh MT respectively.

Bihar is a Decentralized Procurement States (DCP). The State Government procures, stores and distributes foodgrains as per their National Food Security Act (NFSA)/ Other Welfare Schemes (OWS) requirement. FCI comes into picture in case of less procurement wherein shortfall is bridged by inducting stock or excess procurement wherein excess stock is moved to deficit areas. Bihar State Food & Civil Supplies Corporation Limited (BSFC) is the nodal agency of State Government for the procurement and the distribution of foodgrains under NFSA/OWS.

Haryana is a Non –DCP state. Storage gap in a state is calculated as per norms. Taking available and proposed capacity in these states, the storage capacity is sufficient as per norms.

(c) & (d): Food Corporation of India (FCI) mainly stores food grains (wheat & rice) after procurement for Public Distribution System (PDS) and for maintaining buffer stock, to ensure food security in the country.

Requirement of Storage capacity in FCI depends upon the level of procurement, requirement of buffer norms and Public Distribution System (PDS) operations for food grains (Rice and Wheat). FCI continuously assesses and monitors the storage capacity and based on the requirement and storage gap assessment, storage capacities are created/hired through following schemes at a Pan India level including Haryana and Bihar:-

- 1. Construction of Silos under Public Private Partnership(PPP) mode
- 2. Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme
- 3. Central Sector Scheme "Storage & Godowns"
- 4. Hiring of godown from Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC)/ State Warehousing Corporations (SWCs)/State Agencies
- 5. Private Warehousing Scheme (PWS)
- 6. Creation of godowns under Asset Monetization
