OPERATION OF VANDE BHARAT TRAIN IN PUDUCHERRY

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government plans to operate Vande Bharat trains connecting Puducherry with other parts like Tirupati, Tirunelveli, Coimbatore, Bangaluru and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether any survey is being conducted to assess the possibility of running Vande Bharat in Puducherry and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) and (b) At present, Puducherry is connected to Tirupati, Coimbatore and Bengaluru by two pairs of Mail/Express each. Similarly, one pair Mail/Express is catering to the needs of Puducherry-Tirunelveli sector. As on 24th July, 2024, 102 Vande Bharat train services are operating across the Indian Railways, which includes, 12 Vande Bharat services serving Bengaluru and 4 Vande Bharat services serving Coimbatore while 2 Vande Bharat services serve Tirunelveli and Tirupati each. Besides, introduction of train services, including Vande Bharat services, is an on-going process subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, resource availability, etc.
