CONSTRUCTION OF NEW ROB/RUBs IN WEST BENGAL

1516. SMT. SAJDA AHMED:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the zone-wise list of proposed new ROB/RUB for constructions in West Bengal;**
- (b) whether the Government allocated any funds for the construction of an ROB near Bauria Station under the Kharagpur Division of South Eastern Railway and if so, the details of the allocated funds;**
- (c) whether the construction of ROB/RUB near Fuleswar and Kulgachia Railway Stations under South Eastern Railway have been approved; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) to (d): Sanctioning of works of Road over Bridge (ROB)/Road under Bridge (RUB) in lieu of Level crossings (LCs) is a continuous and dynamic process of Indian Railway. Such works are taken up on the basis of its impact on safety in train operations, mobility of trains & impact for road users and feasibility etc.

During 2014-24, a total of 443 Nos. Road Over Bridges (ROBs) /Road Under Bridge (RUBs) were constructed in West Bengal. Presently, 243 Nos. ROB / RUBs at cost of ₹ 5707 Crore are

sanctioned in West Bengal including the work of construction of ROB in lieu of level crossing (LC) No. 18 near Bauria Station.

The works of preparation of Technical feasibility report/Detailed project report (TFR/DPR) for the construction of ROB/RUB at LCs No. 25 (near Fuleswar) & 35(near Kulgachia) have been taken up.
