(a) and (b): The quantity of foodgrains procured from the farmers from 2014-15 to 2024-25 in the country is at **Annexure-I**

The District-wise wheat procured at Minimum Support Price (MSP) in Rajasthan including Pali Parliamentary constituency is at **Annexure-II**.

The District-wise Pulses procured at MSP under Price Support Scheme (PSS) in Rajasthan including Pali Parliamentary constituency is at **Annexure-III-A, III-B & III-C**. Pulses procured under Price Stabilisation Fund (PSF) in Rajasthan is at **Annexure-III-D**

7357 MT paddy was procured during Kharif Marketing Season 2021-22 only in Hanumangarh & Sriganganagar Districts of Rajasthan. No procurement of coarsegrains has been made in Rajasthan from 2014-15 to 2023-24 Kharif Marketing season.

(c) and (d): Government of India revises MSP for every Kharif and Rabi crop on which procurement of foodgrains is carried out by Government Procuring Agencies. MSP of food grains has increased every year since 2014. The MSP for Wheat, Rice, Coarse grains and Pulses from 2014-15 to 2024-25 is at **Annexure-IV**.
