DECLINE IN THE PRODUCTION OF PATRIOTIC FILMS

1610: SHRI BHAUSAHEB RAJARAM WAKCHAURE:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- a) whether there has been a huge decline in the production of patriotic films during recent times:
- b) if so, the reasons thereof;
- c) the number of patriotic films produced and telecast on Doordarshan till date during the last three years;
- d) whether the Government propose to encourage the production of such films and curb element of violence in films;
- e) if so, the details thereof; and
- f) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(DR. L. MURUGAN)

(a) & (b): The production of films happens broadly through the Film industry and as such no statistics are maintained regarding nature of content, including patriotic content etc, produced in the country.

- (c): However, National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) has produced 1 (One) coproduction film and 13 documentary films related to patriotic content during the last three years. In addition, during the last three years, Doordarshan has telecast 22 films with patriotic content.
- (d) to (f): The films containing scenes/dialogues (audio/visual) of violence are certified by the Central Board of Film Certification strictly in adherence to the guidelines issued under section 5-B of Cinematograph Act.
