**NATIONAL SMALL INDUSTRIES CORPORATION**

1651. DR. JAYANTA KUMAR ROY:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) provides integrated support services to MSMEs and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of projects/schemes being implemented and the physical achievements/progress made in this regard during the last three years, scheme and State-wise;
- (c) the details of the funds sanctioned under various schemes by NSIC during the last three years, scheme and State-wise;
- (d) the details of the beneficiaries under the National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub for establishment of new enterprises during the last three years;
- (e) whether the Government has reviewed the functioning of NSIC to make it more effective; and
- (f) if so, the steps being taken by the Government in this regard?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), a CPSE under the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, provides integrated support services to MSMEs through its various programmes which inter-alia include:

- (i) **Raw Material Assistance (RMA) Scheme:-** Under RMA Scheme, NSIC provides financial assistance to MSMEs against bank guarantee for payment to the suppliers for procurement of raw material. NSIC also facilitates MSMEs to meet their raw material requirement by making arrangements with bulk manufacturers for procuring the material and supplying the same to MSMEs.
- (ii) **Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS):-** NSIC registers Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) under its SPRS. The units registered under SPRS are eligible to get the benefits under Public Procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises Order 2012 as amended from time to time.
- (iii) **MSME GlobalMart Portal:-** NSIC is offering infomediary services through its B2B portal <http://www.MSMEMart.com> which is a one-stop one-window bouquet of aids that provides information on business, technology and finance and also exhibit the core competence of Indian SMEs by way of enabling their digital presence for sustenance and growth.

(iv) **NSIC Technical Services Centres:-** NSIC through its Technical Services Centres and Incubation Centres offer industry oriented demand driven entrepreneurship/skill development training programmes (ESDP). The salient features of ESDP Training Programmes are self-employment generation and skill development, providing opportunity to first generation entrepreneurs to acquire skills for enterprise building and integrated support by way of providing hands on training and entrepreneurship development.

State-wise details of credit facilitation under RMA and achievement under the above programmes during the last three years are given at Annexure-I, II, III and IV respectively.

(d): NSIC implements National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH) Scheme across the country to promote entrepreneurship among the SC-ST and to fulfill the obligations under the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. To boost entrepreneurship among SC-ST, the Hub has taken several interventions which include capacity building programmes, market linkage programmes viz, participation in domestic and foreign exhibitions, organization of Special Vendor Development programmes, workshops/awareness programmes, subsidy on purchase of machinery/equipment, subsidy for registration under Single Point Registration Scheme, subsidy for enrollment on Government promoted e-commerce portals such as GeM, e-khadi, TRIFED, Tribes India, MSME Mart, etc.

Funds allocated and released to NSIC for meeting the expenditure under NSSH during the last three years is given below:
