STATUS OF AMRUT IN BIHAR

NO. 1683. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of ongoing projects and developmental works taken up under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) during the last three years, State-wise including Bihar;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated and utilised under the said mission during the said period, state-wise;
- (c) the details of beneficiaries under the said scheme in Bihar;
- (d) whether there has been any delay in this project; and
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor along with corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

- (a): As reported by the State, the details of ongoing projects under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) State/ Union Territory (UT) wise including Bihar is at ANNEXURE-I.
- (b): The details of State/ UT wise Central Assistance (CA) allocated and utilized under AMRUT in the last three financial years is at ANNEXURE-II.
- (c): As reported by the Government of Bihar, 7.06 lakh water tap connections have been provided under AMRUT & in convergence with other schemes in Bihar. The state has not taken up any projects in Sewerage and Septage sector under AMRUT.

(d) & (e): As reported by the Government of Bihar, during the last three years, the State has physically started one water supply project worth ₹120.56 crore. The state has reported a physical progress of 15% in the said project, as on date.

Under AMRUT, States/ Union Territories (UTs) have been empowered to select, appraise, propose and implement projects. A State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) headed by the Secretary, Urban Development & Housing Department provides technical support to the State High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) headed by the Chief Secretary of the State, to approve, monitor and supervise the implementation of the scheme at the State/ UT level.

To fast-track the completion of pending projects under AMRUT Mission, progress is monitored through dedicated AMRUT portal. The progress is periodically reviewed and monitored by the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) with the States/ UTs & their Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) through regular video conferences, webinars, workshops etc. Further, to ensure timely completion of projects, officials from Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and Project Monitoring Unit (AMRUT) visit States/ Union Territories (UTs) to check/ verify the status of implementation of projects.

As per the available report from the State Government, in this project delay was due to non-availability of land during stipulated time period.
