## **ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Since 2017, India has established open sky agreements with Botswana, Japan, Malta, Morocco, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Tanzania, Zambia, Australia, the Maldives, Canada, and New Zealand. During the Summer Schedule of 2017, a total of around 94 services per week were operating between India and these countries. As on date, this number has grown to 152 services per week.
