The Darbhanga Airport belongs to Indian Air Force (IAF) and Airports Authority of India (AAI) operates an interim Civil Enclave on 4.72 acres of land leased by IAF. Considering the growth of passenger traffic in the region, AAI is developing a New Civil Enclave having Terminal Building of 53250 sqm, capable of serving 3000 passengers during peak hours, with Apron for Seven Code C type of aircraft. Further, Darbhanga Airport was also identified during the 2nd round of bidding and development as under the RCS scheme, wherein capital expenditure amounting to INR 126.85 crore has already been incurred for its development.
