## **NATIONAL HIGHWAY NO. 49**

### 1779. SHRI ANANTA NAYAK:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सड़क परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

(a) whether National Highway No. 49, passing through the State of Odisha is in dilapidated condition and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the said NH which connects major mines in the State is facing heavy traffic flow of trucks on it, if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has received any proposal for widening and repair of the said NH and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) whether National Highway Authority of India has submitted an estimate for the construction and repair of the said NH and if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?

### ANSWER

### THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

#### (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) The said stretch is being maintained in traffic worthy condition through regular operation and maintenance work.

(b) & (c) Yes Sir, it provides connectivity to iron ore mines and coal mines in Keonjhar and Jharsuguda districts. Baharagora - Binjhabahal - Teleibani sections has already been developed to 4 lane and currently under Operation & Maintenance stage. DPR for 4-laning of Kanaktora - Jharsuguda section of NH-49 from Km.0.000 to Km.68.000 is awarded. (d) NHAI has awarded work for construction of animal underpasses in this section for an amount of Rs 203 crore. Further, Operation & maintenance (O&M) agency has been engaged for maintenance of stretches not covered by the Defect Liability Period to maintain highway in traffic worthy condition.
