whether the Government can provide an update on the progress and current status of efforts to enhance Shaheed Bhagat Singh Airport to enable it establish better flight connections to other countries and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

International flight operations are governed by bilateral Air Services Agreement (ASA) between India and the respective countries. In accordance with ASA, Indian designated carriers are free to mount operations to/from any international airport including Shaheed Bhagat Singh International Airport, Chandigarh to foreign destinations as per mutually agreed capacity limits. However, the start of international flights from any point in India is purely a commercial decision of the airlines on the basis of economic viability of the route and other associated factors.
