Pending Applications under Ujjwala Scheme

1826. Shri Dushyant Singh:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is fact that more than seven lakh applications are pending under the Ujjwala Scheme.

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise along with the timeline set for clearance of such pending applications.

(c) whether the Government is providing any subsidies to the beneficiaries of the PMUY on refilling of the cylinders and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the details of the beneficiaries under the scheme in the country, particularly in Rajasthan, district-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Yes Sir. Receipt of applications and release of connections under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) is an ongoing process. Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) was launched on 01.05.2016 to release deposit free LPG connection to adult women from poor households across the country. The target to release 8 crore connections was achieved in September, 2019. To cover the remaining poor households, PMUY phase-2 (Ujjwala 2.0) was launched in August 2021 and till January 2023, 1.60 crore Ujjwala 2.0 connections had been released. Further, in view of fresh requests, in September 2023, Government approved release of additional 75 lakh PMUY connections. OMCs have completed the release of these 75 lac PMUY connections as of 8th July 2024. State/UT wise details of pending PMUY applications are given as **Annexure – A**. No timelines have been fixed in this regard.

(c): W.e.f. 21st May, 2022, Government has been providing a targeted subsidy of Rs. 200 per 14.2 Kg LPG cylinder for Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) beneficiaries for upto 12 refills a year. Moreover, w.e.f. 5th October, 2023, Government increased the targeted subsidy to Rs. 300 per 14.2 Kg LPG cylinder for all Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) beneficiaries. With a targeted subsidy of Rs. 300 per cylinder (and proportionately prorated for 5 Kg cylinder), effective cost for PMUY consumers is Rs. 503 per 14.2 Kg cylinder (at Delhi) currently.

(d): As on 01.07.2024, 10.33 Crore connections across the country including 73.81 lakh connections in the state of Rajasthan have been released under PMUY.

State/UT-wise and District-wise (Rajasthan) details of LPG connections released under PMUY are at **Annexure-B** and **Annexure – C** respectively.
