SCHEMES FOR WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN RURAL AREAS

+1859. SHRI DILESHWAR KAMAIT:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the schemes being implemented by the Government for the development of women and children across the country including rural areas;
- (b) the details of the achievements made under the said schemes, State/UT-wise particularly in Bihar;
- (c) the amount of funds allocated/released and utilized thereunder during the last four years and the current year, State/UT-wise including Bihar;
- (d) whether the Government has taken any new initiatives to make women self-reliant; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI ANNUPURNA DEVI)

(a) to (e) For better implementation and efficient monitoring, all schemes implemented by the Ministry for the development of women and children have been clubbed into three verticals, viz. (1) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 for improving nutrition& health indicators in the country (2) Mission Shakti, for safety, protection and empowerment of women; and (3) Mission Vatsalya, for protection, care and welfare of children in difficult circumstances. Details of the schemes are as under:

(i) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 (Mission Poshan 2.0): Under this programme, Anganwadi Services Scheme, POSHAN Abhiyaan and Scheme for Adolescent Girls have been reorganized into 3 primary sub-verticals: (i) Nutrition Support for POSHAN and for Adolescent Girls (ii) Early Childhood Care and Education

[3-6 years] and (iii) Anganwadi Infrastructure including modern, upgraded Saksham Anganwadis.

(ii) Mission Shakti: Mission Shakti comprises of two sub-verticals, i.e., '**Sambal**' for safety and security of women and '**Samarthya**' for empowerment of women. The existing schemes of One Stop Centres (OSC), Women Helpline (181-WHL) and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) have been made part of Sambal sub-vertical; while the existing schemes of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), Ujjwala, SwadharGreh (renamed as Shakti Sadan) and Working Women Hostel (renamed as Sakhi Niwas), National Hub for Empowerment of Women (NHEW) and National Creche Scheme (renamed as Palna) have been subsumed in the 'Samarthya' sub-vertical.

(iii) Mission Vatsalya: Mission Vatsalya has subsumed the Integrated Child Protection Scheme(ICPS) for better outreach and protection for children in need and care in a mission mode with the objective to: (i) Support and sustain Children in difficult circumstances. (ii) Develop context-based solutions for holistic development of children from varied backgrounds. (iii) Provide scope for green field projects for encouraging innovative solutions. (iv) Cement convergent action by gap funding, if required.

The details of the achievements/ new initiatives made by the Ministry for women empowerment and child development are as under:

I. MISSION SAKSHAM ANGANWADI & POSHAN 2.0

- **Anganwadi Protocol for Management of Malnutrition at the Community Level (CMAM Protocol):** For the first time, a standardised national 'Protocol for Management of Malnourished Children' (CMAM Protocol) has been drafted by MoWCD with inputs from MoHFW, providing detailed steps for identification and management of malnourished children at the Anganwadi level, including decision-making for referral, nutritional management and follow-up care. The protocol was launched on 10th October, 2023.
- **Millets are included in the Supplementary Nutrition Programme.** In Poshan Pakhwada 2023, one crore activities were carried out for awareness and popularisation of millets for health. Under the Poshan 2.0 Scheme guidelines, millets have to be mandatorily provided under Supplementary Nutrition once a week. Six **region-wise diet charts** have been developed for pregnant women, viz., North, North-East, West, South, East and Central.
- **Migration facility for beneficiaries from one AWC to another:** In case the beneficiary is registered at another AWC, she/he shall be migrated to the new AWC during the period of stay through the migration facility in the Poshan Tracker. Migration facility for beneficiaries from one AWC to another within and

outside a State has been facilitated under the Poshan Tracker. Migration facility from one category to another category of beneficiary is also available.

- **6.42 lakh Poshan Vatikas or nutri-gardens** have been planted at Anganwadi Centres for access to local, fresh vegetables, fruits and herbs. Besides, 1.1 lakh medicinal plants have been planted across six states.
- **Poshan Bhi Padhai Bhi (PBPB)**, launched on 10th May, 2023, is a pathbreaking ECCE program to help India develop the world's largest, universal, high-quality pre-school network at Anganwadi Centres, in alignment with the new National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
- **MoU with Ministry of AYUSH**: The Ministry signed an MoU with Ministry of AYUSH in February 2024 for the nutritional improvement in adolescent girls through Ayurveda interventions. Both the Ministries have entered into this MoU with the aim of nutritional improvement of approximately 95,000 adolescent girls in the Anaemia prone districts (where average prevalence of Anaemia is approx. 69.5%). This project will cover approximately 10,000 Anganwadi centers in the five districts.
- **PM JANMAN**: A total number of 916 Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) under PM-JANMAN has been sanctioned and out of which 520 AWCs have been operationalized till date.

II. MISSION SHAKTI

- **Women Helpline- "One Nation One Helpline"**: Women Helpline has been operationalized in 35 States/UTs (except West Bengal) and integrated with Emergency Response Support System (112) in 33 States/UTs. In 2023-24, a total of 21.1 lakh calls have been received and 10.08 lakh women have been assisted. Further, Women Helpline has been integrated with Child Helpline and District Child Protection Units in 30 States/UTs. Further, 251 One Stop Centres have been integrated with WHL till date for providing seamless helpline services to women and children.
- **Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY)**: A National Event on Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) was held at Mumbai, Maharashtra on 27th October 2023. The event included the release of a comprehensive User Manual for various stakeholders including Citizens, Field Functionaries, Supervisors, Sanctioning Officers, District Nodal Officers and State Nodal Officers for the New PMMVY Portal (PMMVY soft MIS).
- **Hub for Empowerment of Women**, a component of Sub-Scheme 'Samarthaya' under umbrella scheme for safety, security and empowerment of women "Mission Shakti" has been introduced to facilitate inter-sectoral convergence of schemes and programs meant for women both at the central

(NHEW), State/ UT level (SHEW) and district level (DHEW) with the mandate to create an environment in which women realize their full potential.

- The Shakti Sadan component is specifically designed to cater to the destitute and women in difficult circumstances. Under Shakti Sadan component, one of the services provided is vocational training to the residents of such homes. Further, the women helpline (181), which is a 24 hours emergency and non-emergency response to women affected by violence, both in public and private spaces by linking them with appropriate authorities, also provide information about women welfare schemes and programs across the country.

III. MISSION VATSALYA

- **Model Foster Care Guidelines 2024**

- The Model Foster Care Guidelines 2024 were issued on 26.4.2024 and shared with the States/UTs. The guidelines have been revised in the light of amendment in the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Act 2015 and Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Model Amendment Rules, 2022.
- The revised guidelines have been framed to ensure clarity, efficiency and compliance amongst stakeholders about Foster Care with an objective to facilitate stay of children in family-like settings instead of staying in child care institutions for a long time. The guidelines provide procedural clarity, eligibility conditions and detailed steps for administering Foster Care and such Foster Care ultimately leading to Adoption by the same foster family who have kept the child in their care for a period of two years.
