Ayurvedic Hospitals and Universities under NAM

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of total number of Ayurvedic hospitals and Ayurvedic Universities included under the National Ayush Mission (NAM) in the country, State/UT-wise, particularly in Maharashtra;
- (b) whether the Ayurvedic hospitals and Universities in Parbhani and Dharashiv districts of Maharashtra have been included in the NAM scheme and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the shortage of Unani, Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic hospitals and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in Parbhani and Dharashiv districts in the said mission;
- (d) whether any efforts have been made to grow Ayurvedic plants and upgradation of Government Ayurvedic Hospitals and Universities located in Dharashiv and Parbhani districts of Maharashtra; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) and (b) Ministry of Ayush is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), through State/UT Governments for overall development &

promotion of Ayush system in the country including Parbhani and Dharashiv districts of Maharashtra, and providing financial assistance to them under different activities against their proposals received through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per the provisions of NAM guideline. However, under NAM, there is no provision to support for Ayurvedic Universities. State/UT-wise number of Ayurvedic Hospitals is furnished at **Annexure-I.** Further, under NAM scheme, as per the proposals received form the State Government of Maharashtra through SAAP, Ministry of Ayush has approved Rs. 100.00 lakhs for setting up of Integrated Ayush Hospital at Dharashiv District during the year 2023-24.

(c) Public health being a State subject, the establishment of adequate numbers of Unani, Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic hospitals and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in Parbhani and Dharashiv districts lies with respective State Government. However, as reported by State Government of Maharashtra, there is no shortage of above mention facilities in these Districts.

(d) and (e) Activity of the cultivation of medicinal plants had been implemented under the component of "Medicinal Plants" through Centrally Sponsored Scheme of NAM since 2015-16 to 2020-21 and after that the same was delinked from NAM scheme. Ministry of Ayush has supported 56305-hectare area for cultivation of medicinal plants throughout the country including Maharashtra from the year 2015-16 to 2020-21 under the medicinal plants component of NAM and details are furnished as **Annexure-II**.

Further, under NAM, as per the proposal received from State Government of Maharashtra through SAAP, Ayurvedic hospital Dharashiv which is attached to Government Ayurvedic College has been supported for upgradation and an amount of Rs. 54.205 lakhs has been approved for the same during the year 2023-24.
