Will the Minister of **HEALTH and FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of the funds spent on development of health infrastructure under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission in the State of Maharashtra during the last three years;
- (b) the number of Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centres set up/proposed to be set up under the said Mission in Maharashtra;
- (c) the details of the guidelines for setting up/upgrading the Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) under the Mission; and
- (d) the number of HWCs set up/proposed to be set up in Palghar District of Maharashtra?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (d) Under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission, Government of India releases funds to States/UTs for implementation of ABDM. The funds are released for Human Resources, Information, Education, Communication and Capacity Building Activities.

The financial year-wise funds released under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission to Maharashtra are as follows:

- 1. FY 2021-22 Rs. 55,35,881/- for Human Resources, Information, Education, Communication and Capacity Building Heads.
- 2. FY 2022-23 Rs. 43,53,300/- for Human Resources, Information, Education, Communication and Capacity Building Heads.
- 3. FY 2023-24 Rs. 40,00,000/- for Human Resources, Information, Education, Communication and Capacity Building Heads.

As on 30.06.2024, a total of 11,448 Ayushman Arogya Mandir have been operationalized in Maharashtra by upgrading existing SHCs and PHCs to deliver comprehensive primary health care (CPHC) that includes preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative services which are universal, free, and closer to the community.
