NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION IN HIMACHAL PRADESH

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of districts that are not performing well in developing healthcare infrastructure in Himachal Pradesh, district-wise;
- (b) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government under the National Health Mission to strengthen the healthcare infrastructure in Himachal Pradesh, district-wise; and
- (c) the details of funds allocated, sanctioned and released on healthcare infrastructure along with the current progress of the healthcare infrastructure development in Himachal Pradesh?

(a) to (c): Under National Health Mission (NHM), financial and technical support is provided to States/UTs to strengthen their healthcare systems, based on the requirements posed by them within their overall resource envelope. Under NHM, proposals are received from all States/ UTs in the form of Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs). Government of India provides approval for the proposals in the form of Record of Proceedings (RoPs) as per norms & available resources.

As on 30.06.2024, a total of 2,438 Ayushman Arogya Mandir (AAM) have been operationalized in Himachal Pradesh by upgrading existing SHCs and PHCs to deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) that includes preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative services which are universal, free, and closer to the community. Number of AAMs operationalized in Himachal Pradesh, district-wise, is at Annexure-I.

Number of projects approved for construction under PM-Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM) and Fifteenth Finance Commission (FC-XV) in the State of Himachal Pradesh, district-wise, for FY 2021-22 to 2023-24 is at Annexure-II.

The details of funds allocated and released under PM-ABHIM and FC-XV from the FY 2021-22 to 2024-25 for State of Himachal Pradesh, is as follows:
