Will the Minister of **Ayush** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the work has been started for AYUSH Kendra in Kinaloor Village in Kasargod in Kerala and 90 crores rupees alloted for this purpose;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons for delay in construction work of the project;
- (c) whether the said project is still under consideration of the Government, if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether this project will be started, if so, the details thereof alongwith the time it will take for completion and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether there is any hurdles on implementing this project; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof along with the details of the funds allocated for this project so far and pending to be released in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (f): At present, there is no such proposal for an AYUSH Kendra in Kinaloor Village in Kasargod, Kerala.
