EMPLOYMENT GENERATION OPPORTUNITIES

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) The details and data of employment generation opportunities in various sectors in the country for the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether the Government has conducted any institution-based labour survey to ascertain the data; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (c): As per the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) latest KLEMS data, total employment was 56.56 crore, 57.75 crore, 59.67 crore and 64.33 crore in the year 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 in the country, respectively.

Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation conducts Annual Survey of Unincorporated Sector Enterprises (ASUSE) and Annual Survey of Industries (ASI). ASUSE exclusively measures various economic and operational characteristics of unincorporated, non-agricultural establishments in manufacturing, trade and other services sector. ASI is a major source of data of registered manufacturing sector of the Indian Economy.

Further, Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour and Employment conducted Quarterly Employment Survey (QES) to assess employment situation in respect of selected nine sectors of non-farm economy of India over successive quarters.
