2126. SHRI MAGUNTA SREENIVASULU REDDY:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of working individuals (men, women and others) over the last five years in the country, State-wise;**
- (b) whether the Government has undertaken any schemes/projects/initiatives for the purposes of increasing the number of working women across various sectors, if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the details of the beneficiaries of such schemes over the last five years in the country, State-wise, especially in the State of Andhra Pradesh;**
- (d) the details of funds allocated and utilised for the purposes of increasing the number of working women in the country during the last five years, State-wise, especially in the State of Andhra Pradesh; and**
- (e) whether the Government has carried out any promotional activity/campaign for the purposes of increasing the numbers of working women in the country, especially from the rural sector, if so details thereof?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT

(a) to (e): The official data source on Employment and Unemployment is Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June every year. As per the latest available Annual PLFS reports, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above in the country, State-wise is at Annexure-I.

Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. The Government has taken various schemes/ projects/ initiatives/measures to increase the number of working women across various sectors including the State of Andhra Pradesh.

Government has incorporated a number of provisions in the labour laws for equal opportunity and congenial work environment for women workers like paid maternity leave, child care leave, creche facility, equal wages etc.

Government is implementing various schemes to boost the female LFPR as well as the overall LFPR like Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), Stand-UP India Scheme, Startup India, Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Women in Science and Engineering- KIRAN (WISE-KIRAN), SERB-POWER (Promoting Opportunities for Women in Exploratory Research), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETIs), Deen Dayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), Production Linked Incentive, etc. The details of various employment generation schemes/ programmes being implemented by the Government of India may be seen at https://dge.gov.in/dge/schemes_programmes.

The details of the beneficiaries of such schemes and details of funds utilised over the last five years in the country, including Andhra Pradesh is at Annexure-II to VII.

To enhance the employability of female workers, the Government is providing training to them through a network of Women Industrial Training institutes, National Vocational Training Institutes and Regional Vocational Training Institutes.

Further, Government announced in the Budget 2024-25, the Prime Minister's package of 5 schemes and initiatives to facilitate employment, skilling and other opportunities for 4.1 crore youth over a 5-year period with a central outlay of Rs. 2 lakh crore.
