Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to digitally empower the girl students of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas in the country especially in Haryana, Jharkhand and Maharashtra;
- (b) the number of girl students benefitted by these vidyalayas State-wise, especially in Haryana, Jharkhand and Maharashtra and district-wise in Khandwa Parliamentary Constituency, Madhya Pradesh, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to conduct any investigation through a Central Committee to check the quality education in the said schools functioning in Darbhanga district of Bihar; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a): Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) are residential schools from class VI to XII, set up in Educationally Backward Blocks for girls belonging to disadvantaged groups such as SC, ST, OBC, Minority and Below Poverty Line (BPL) under Samagra Shiksha Scheme.

Under Information & Communication Technology (ICT) Component of "Samagra Shiksha" Scheme, financial assistance is provided to States/UTs for establishing Smart Classrooms and ICT labs in KGBVs. It aims to provide basic infrastructure to the students and transform the classroom into techdriven class. The students increase engagement with multimedia content and interactive activities, while availing wider range of resources. This fosters deeper understanding, collaboration, and digital literacy for students, enriching their overall educational experience. At present, ICT labs and Smart classrooms are available in 1500 KGBVs and 2880 KGBVs respectively.

Further, States/UTs have been requested to saturate all the functional KGBVs with ICT labs and Smart classrooms and Central Government will provide support as per the norms prescribed under Samagra Shiksha Scheme for this purpose.

(b): The State-wise number of girls enrolled in KGBVs, including in Haryana, Jharkhand and Maharashtra, is enclosed at Annexure I. Khandwa Parliamentary Constituency, Madhya Pradesh covers areas of Burhanpur, Dewas, Khandwa and Khargone districts. District-wise number of girls enrolled in Khandwa Parliamentary Constituency, Madhya Pradesh is enclosed at Annexure II.
