STATUS OF EMPLOYMENT

2299. SHRI TATKARE SUNIL DATTATREY:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the unemployment rate is lowest in the country during the last five years;
- (b) the status of employment in rural areas of the country; and
- (c) the status of employment in urban areas of the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (c): The data on Employment and Unemployment is collected through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June every year.

As per the data available in latest Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated Unemployment Rate (UR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above was 5.8%, 4.8%, 4.2%, 4.1% and 3.2% during 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23, respectively. The data indicates that the unemployment rate in the country has a declining trend over the years.

Further, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR), indicating employment, on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above in the rural and urban areas during the years 2018-19 to 2022-23 are as follows:
